Suggested actions and movement



Grab some shells if you have them and place them in the middle of a cleared space in the room.



Move around the shells in a circle making 'searching' actions, then pick up a shell from the middle. If you don't have shells, make a round shape with both hands.



Wiggle fingers around the shell making a shiny action.



Action to add for treasure of the beach



Repeat shell and shiny actions then made a big and small action with hands.



Finish song by repeating shell, shiny and treasure actions.

Suggested adaptations

0-1yr

Perform the actions of the song for baby and use washed real shells if you have them to add an extra sensory element. For very young babies, these could be put inside a bottle with water to allow them to see the shells, but avoid them putting them anywhere near their mouth.

Equipment:

- · Basic biscuit dough
- Piping bag
- Butter icing
- · Smarties or white chocolate buttons
- 1. Make up the biscuit dough, bake and leave to cool.
- 2. Make up buttercream icing and place into the piping bag.
- 3. When the biscuits are fully cooled, place half of them upside down on a tray and pipe icing onto the biscuits.
- 4. Place the other half of the biscuits on the top of the icing offset so that they look like an open clamshell.
- 5. Add a smartie or chocolate button for a pearl and enjoy!
