

### Suggested actions and movement for every verse

Chorus actions - to start song and after every verse

• Start standing tall with hands on hips. Put one hand out in front of body to make a superhero action.



Lift one arm up to show fuerte ~ strong first and then the other up to show valiente ~ brave. Then grab hands towards shoulders to make a capa ~ cape action.

Run quickly on the spot.



Jump up as high as you can!

Verse actions



Fly around the space like a superhero!



Repeat the introduction with both chorus parts and enjoy being a superheroe!

### Suggested adaptations

Stand up and be a superhero with baby too! Place one arm on your hip while holding baby in the chorus, then bring it out in front of you to be a superheroe!

**0-1yr** 

 Follow the actions for each verse interacting with baby, running gently on the spot, lifting baby up to climb, bouncing them up and down to jump, then fly them around the room.

This session's song is perfect for some dressing up so dig out the costumes if you have them or make your own superhero mask and let children decorate it however they like to feel just like a superheroe en el parque infantil.

### You could use:

White card, elastic, black marker, scissors, coloured pens, pencils or crayons and any other craft items.

Draw a mask template on the white card, or find a printable one online.

Have children decorate the template first, leave to dry if needed, cut out and secure elastic for them to wear their mask.
