Suggested adaptations

0-2yrs

Enjoy performing the actions in front of baby or toddler making lots of exaggerated gestures and if you have props, then involve them too.
Eg: Picnic basket, play food and plastic bottles for drinks and a picnic blanket too. ¡Qué aproveche! Enjoy!

EL PARQUE - THE PARK

Focus word: picnic ~ un picnic (oon peehk-neehek)



Why not try...

Weaving loom

Un telar

Equipment: Cardboard (corrugated if possible), scissors, strips of coloured paper around an inch wide, string, masking tape.

Use a rectangle of cardboard around the size of an A4 piece of paper, cut 1 inch slits into the top and bottom of the card lined up as best as possible.

Wrap string from top to bottom and tie at the back - repeat for each set of slits. You should have a board with strings that looks like a giant guitar.

Tape one end of the loom to the table, so it's more manageable for little hands.

Show children how to weave over and under the strings using the coloured strips of paper to create a basic loom.

This could be displayed as artwork, or cut into shapes of picnic baskets. Ensure to stick down the ends of the strips of paper before cutting.
