| <p>START HERE ① Point fingers in front, then nod head three times and stick thumbs up on 'yes' and 'sí' words.</p> | <p>③ Tap wrist as if tapping a watch, then point forward to indicate 'your turn' ~ 'tu turno'.</p> | <p>⑤ Push arms back behind body as if pushing yourself down a slide. Finish the verse by putting arms up in the air and shouting 'Hooray' ~ 'Olé'.</p> |
| <p>② Make a climbing up the steps action using exaggerated movements with both arms and legs.</p> | <p>END HERE ④ Sit down on the ground with legs stretched out in front. Put hands out to the side as if grabbing the top of the slide ready to go down.</p> | <p>Repeat the introduction actions and make your happiest face at the end!</p> |

- This is a lovely song for sitting baby on your lap, holding hands and enjoying some fun together, you could also get up and moving if you prefer. Enjoy bouncing baby along to the rhythm on the song, raise them up with by bending your knees more as if they were climbing the steps and slide them down your knees towards you to enjoy a fun slide at home!

Apply and reinforce the vocabulary from this song in real life by singing it when you're at the playground!

Observation Opportunities



Associate vocabulary with actions and demonstrate understand in both languages.

Demonstrate control when moving between actions eg, from standing to sitting

Develop self awareness by understanding the need for waiting your turn.

Enjoy songs and rhymes, tuning in and paying attention

Enjoy pretend play making actions as though riding the slide in real life.

Round up as many tubes as you can of different sizes and widths. Ask other parents to give any tubes they can find at home and use them to create tube slides in your setting.

You could use small world figures, or cars to put down the tubes and even hold some races to see which ones are the fastest slides.

This is an open ended activity that can provide a great deal of exploration of materials AND plenty of entertainment too.

You could join tubes together with sellotape and make super slides in the home, setting or even outside.
