Why not try....

Paper Plate Roundabouts Carruseles de platos de papel

Get creative and constructive with this simple roundabout ~ carrusel craft activity!

Equipment: Paper plates, split pins, scissors, ruler, pencil, felt tips or paints.

- Each child will need 2 paper plates, one for the base and one for the roundabout itself
- 2. Prep the roundabout plate for each child by drawing 3 lines across with a ruler and pencil to divide it into 6 segments.
- 3. Have children decorate their roundabout using alternating colours for the segments.
- 4. Place the base plate upside down and the roundabout plate on top the right way round.
- 5. Use pointed scissors or similar to oke a hole through the middle of both of the plates and push the split pin through.
- 6. When finished, the top plate should be able to turn just like a roundabout and the alternating colours make it interesting to watch as it turns round.
