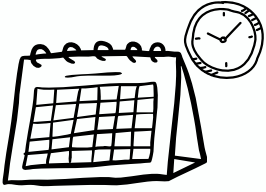

Setting up your EnCantada Class



Choose a day and time that suits your learners best

Have a think about when your children are at their most responsive, the days of the week they tend to engage better and the time of day they find it easier to focus. Plan to start then and build it into your weekly routine.

Familiarise yourself with the format

Each full session is 35-40mins, with a Welcome section, Instrument section, Movement or Hand Action section, Adventure section and Goodbye song. Each song is listed on the session page. You can decide if you want to deliver the session as a full class, or in shorter bursts throughout the day or week. Depending on the age and attention span of your learners.



Plan your space to work with you



A large, clear space will allow for more enhanced focus on the session itself, so make a point of creating that before starting. Within that space, make sure each child will be able to clearly see the screen, to move a little when playing their instruments as well as allowing for a wider area to dance in when we get up and moving!

Resources you will need

Musical instruments and something to dance with are the only essentials, but you can be as imaginative as you like with these. Keep them in a box or bag in your session space helping to create routine for each class and encouraging responsibility too. If any additional resources are needed, they will always be listed on the session page.



Inspire them with your enthusiasm



Joining in with the interactive elements of the session helps the children to learn from your wonderful example and gives them the confidence to try too! Check out the focus word guidance notes before the session for a heads up and to pick out any resources you feel would complement the children's experience.

Think progress over perfection!

We all make mistakes, even in our native language! Offering Spanish in your learning environment is a fantastic opportunity for the young learners in your care. Pronunciation isn't the objective, so if you make mistakes, embrace them! Laying the foundation for future language learning is about allowing for exposure in an encouraging environment that builds confidence, so keep that in mind at all times.
