Focus word: el eteño ~ the Autumn - (ehl eh-teh-nyeh)

This session's song

Autumn Leaves Las hojas del otoño

Suggested actions & movement



Using real, or artficial leaves, this songs works really well with a parachute or large sheet.

Put the leaves on top and enjoy making them fly around! In verse 3, bring them all the way down to the ground gently then whizz them up in the air in verse 4.

Disclaimer: The leaves will go everywhere, but the kids will love it!

Standing Actions

- Make leaves with your hands bringing them down in front of the body to show falling down.
- Twist wrists and make rolling arm action to show swirling action of the leaves moving to the ground.
- 3 Move hands from side to side down near the ground.
- 4 Quickly bring arms up to show a gust of wind.
- Repeat Verse I actions.

Suggested adaptations



- VI Gently move your fingers down over baby's tummy.
- V2 Use the tips of your fingers to make a swirling action around baby's tummy.
- V3 Make sssh noise and put finger on lips.
- VY Gently blow to make the sensation of the wind and move fingers up baby's tummy and arms. Repeat VI action to finish.

Why not try...

Autumn Crown Corona del otoño

Equipment: Strips of card, Autumn leaves, PVA glue, stapler or sellotape

- 1. Gather together fallen autumn leaves and other autumnal found items.
- 2. Cut strips of card measured to the size of each child's head.
- 3. Let children decorate their strip of card with their chosen items and leave to dry.
- 4. Secure together with sellotape or staple with the smooth side on the inside and the prongs covered with one of the leaves.
